# Welcome Message



Greetings, and salam sejahtera.

On behalf of the Organising Committee, it gives me great pleasure to welcome you to Coloproctology 2022, the 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Scientific Congress of the Malaysian Society of Colorectal Surgeons (MSCRS).

The past two years can be said to have been one of the most disruptive periods in surgical history, due to that arch-nemesis, the COVID-19 pandemic. Surgical services were curtailed, surgeons were retrained and redeployed to non-surgical arenas, and surgical training was severely disrupted. With healthcare resources redistributed and focused towards COVID-19 cases, management of non-COVID diseases suffered from delays, with resultant poorer outcomes. Diversity and inclusivity in our teams are crucial, if we are to harness the breadth of knowledge, skills and behaviours needed to create innovative solutions to new problems.

There are silver linings to be found in every cloud. We have become comfortable with the benefits of the virtual world, learning how best to combine platforms for the most effective dissemination of knowledge. Telemedicine has helped to decongest clinics and hospitals, without reducing quality of care. Simulation and artificial intelligence have helped to minimize the negative impacts on surgical training.

The Organising Committee has kept all of this in mind when drawing up the scientific programme. You will find contributions from around the world, addressing each of the issues highlighted above. While there are separate tracks focusing on surgeons, allied health professionals, colorectal cancer survivors and trainees, there has been a concerted effort to integrate the content, further emphasising the value of teamwork.

Although we have had to make the difficult decision to remain on a virtual platform for Coloproctology 2022, we believe that you will still derive many of the same educational benefits that a face-to-face activity would allow. I look forward to interacting with you in the 'Alam Maya', or virtual world, very soon.

# Call for Abstracts

## BEST POSTER AWARD

The Best Poster is for the best original scientific or clinical paper submitted by young surgeons in Malaysia for presentation at the Coloproctology 2022. This award will hopefully encourage a high standard of research and scientific presentations among young surgeons.

## THE PRIZE

There will be three (3) Best Poster Awards:

1<sup>st</sup> Prize - RM1,000

2<sup>nd</sup> Prize - RM750

3<sup>rd</sup> Prize - RM500

## REGULATIONS

1. The competition is open to all young surgeons and surgical trainees currently working in Malaysian institutions who are below 35 years old as on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022.
2. The work submitted may be from any surgical specialty, and it may take the form of clinical trials, surveys, retrospective studies, laboratory experiments or any other form of unpublished original work.
3. The bulk of the work which are submitted must be performed by the author himself/herself even though he/she may have done the work in conjunction with other doctors or agencies either locally or overseas. However, the work must be carried out in Malaysia.
4. The author must submit a signed declaration of his/her age, that his/her paper has not been published or presented elsewhere and the presenter has done most of the work.
5. The abstracts for poster presentation are to be submitted online at [www.colorectalmy.org](http://www.colorectalmy.org)
6. The closing date for receipt of abstracts is 30<sup>th</sup> January 2022.

## SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

### GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. No limit is imposed on the number of abstracts submitted by individuals.
2. Abstracts are to be submitted in English only.
3. Abstracts must be accompanied by payment of registration fees. If the abstract is subsequently not accept for presentation, and the author wishes to cancel his participation, the registration fee will be refunded to the author.
4. The final selection will be the responsibility of the Scientific Committee.

## Call for Abstracts

### WHERE APPROPRIATE, THE ABSTRACTS SHOULD CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING

1. A statement of the objectives of the study.
2. A description of the methods used.
3. A summary of the results obtained.
4. A statement of the conclusions reached.

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARATION OF ABSTRACTS

1. The abstract should not exceed 300 words.
2. Title must be in CAPITAL letters on the first line. Do not indent.
3. Author(s) name(s) and institution(s). Do not include degrees or professional titles. A maximum of four (4) authors can be listed.
4. Underline the name of the presenting author.
5. Leave one line between the title / author / institution and the body of the abstract.
6. Texts must be typed single-spaced, with only the left margin justified. Graphs, tables and illustrations cannot be included in the abstract.
