18. MEMBERSHIP

There will be five (5) types of membership, namely: Member, Associate Member, Affiliate Member, Corporate member and Honorary Member.

13.1 Definition

13.1.1 Member

Basic qualification include:

- i) Must be Malaysian citizen aged 18 and above
- ii) Working and residing in Malaysia
- iii) A general surgeon who has at least 3 years of working experience after passing a locally recognized postgraduate specialty examination
- iv) Satisfactory completion of at least 12 (twelve) months training in a recognized center for Colorectal Surgery.
- vi) 50% of clinical work is in related to Colorectal Surgery
- vii) Eligible to hold office in MSCRS and has voting rights.

13.1.2 Associate Member

Any surgeon who does not fulfill all the qualifications for being a Member. Not eligible to hold office in MSCRS and has no voting rights.

13.1.3 Affiliate Member

All categories of health care providers including doctors, undergraduate and postgraduate medical students. These students must get written approval from the University concerned prior to joining the society. Not eligible to hold office in MSCRS and has no voting rights

13.1.4 Corporate member

Any legally constituted institution or body that is supportive of the Society's objectives and work.

13.1.5 Honorary Member

Any individual who has made significant contributions to the Society or to the field of Colorectal Surgery.
